## Frequently Asked Questions

S.NO.	QUERIES	ANSWERS
1.	What is AIAPGET?	AIAPGET is an entrance examination namely 'All India AYUSH Post Graduate Entrance Test' for admission to Postgraduate AYUSH Courses. All India and State quota seats for admission to MD/ MS Courses in Ayurveda, Unani, Siddha & Homoeopathy system of medicine for all AYUSH Colleges, Institutions & Universities/ Deemed Universities across the country.
2.	What is the responsibility of NTA for AIAPGET?	The responsibility of NTA is limited to inviting online application, conduct of entrance test, declaration of results and providing All India rank of candidates to The National Commission for Indian System of Medicine (NCISM) and National Commission for Homoeopathy (NCH) for admission into Post Graduate Courses in Ayurveda, Unani, Siddha & Homeopathy system of medicine.
3.	Will NTA reserve its discretion to fix the centre in a city which is given in the Information Bulletin?	As far as possible the candidate will be given the chosen city for the test. However, NTA may allot a different city due to administrative reasons.
4.	Can a centre be allotted by the NTA manually?	No
5.	Is there any Negative Marking in the AIAPGET?	There is Negative Marking in AIAPGET.
6.	Is there any helpline for AIAPGET Examination for the aspirants?	Yes. Details are available on website- <a href="http://www.nta.ac.in">www.nta.ac.in</a> , <a href="https://exams.nta.ac.in/AIAPGET/">https://exams.nta.ac.in/AIAPGET/</a> Helpline No.- 01140759000 (Operational 09:30 AM to 06:00 PM during working days)
7.	Is there any other place where queries can be raised?	Yes. Candidates may send mail to helpdesk.
8.	Whether the examination will be offline or online?	It is an online examination conducted through Computer Based Test.
9.	What is the medium of Question paper?	The medium of question paper is: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Ayurveda- English and Hindi</li> <li>Unani- English and Urdu</li> <li>Siddha- English and Tamil</li> <li>Homoeopathy- English only</li> </ul>
10.	How will a candidate select a city of their choice for examination?	It is mandatory for candidates to select four test cities of their choice based on their Permanent Address and Present Address. While filling up the Online Application Form, candidates should select four cities from Appendix I of the Information Bulletin as their Choice of Cities for the Test Centre in order of their priority.
11.	What would be the Validity of AIAPGET 2025 result?	The validity of the results of AIAPGET 2025 shall be only for the current admission session i.e. 2025-26 for Post graduate courses and cannot be carried forward for the next session.



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12.	In case, the Candidate has uploaded Blue Signature instead of a Black Signature in the application form of AIAPGET. Is it okay?	Your Application Form will not be rejected merely for this mistake.
13.	What is the syllabus for AIAPGET?	The syllabus for the exam shall comprise of subjects/knowledge areas as per the Graduate Level Education Regulations of respective discipline issued by NCISM/NCH. Kindly refer to the NCISM/NCH for complete syllabus document.
14.	What is the duration/timing of AIAPGET?	The detailed pattern of examination is mentioned in Information bulletin available on website <a href="https://exams.nta.ac.in/AIAPGET/">https://exams.nta.ac.in/AIAPGET/</a>
15.	What should I do, if 'continuous timeout' or 'file not found' error occurs while filling online application form of AIAPGET?	Use the updated version of browser with good internet connection while filling in the application form. In case of continuous time out one can clear cookies and history of the browser and fill in off-peak hours.
16.	What are the enclosures that should be attached with the confirmation page to be sent to NTA?	Candidates are not required to send/submit any document(s) including Confirmation Page to NTA through Post/ Fax/ By Hand.
17.	Does NTA verify the documents and what is the role of NTA in counselling?	NTA does not verify the information provided by the candidates during online registration and hence candidature will be <b>purely provisional</b> subject to fulfillment of eligibility criteria as per NCISM/NCH/States/Universities/Institutions/ Deemed Universities concerned. <b>NTA has no role in counselling.</b>
18.	Will the fee be refunded if the candidate does not appear for the examination?	No
19.	What do the candidates need to bring to the exam center?	<p>The candidate is required to bring the following to the examination centre (Also read the Information Bulletin carefully):-</p> <p>Admit Card along with undertaking.</p> <p>One passport size photograph to be affixed to the attendance sheet.</p> <p>Candidates are advised not to bring any other item in the examination centres. There will be no arrangement for safe keeping of any material at the centre. Neither NTA nor centre will be responsible for any loss, delay etc.</p>



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20.	In case the Photograph does not carry Name & Date of the Photograph, would the form be rejected?	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. The Application form will not be rejected in this case because it is not mandatory to mention Name &amp; Date in Photograph. The photograph should not be with cap or goggles. Spectacles are allowed if being used regularly. Polaroid and Computer-generated photos are not acceptable.</li> <li>2. Candidates may please note that if it is found that photograph uploaded is fabricated i.e. de-shaped or seems to be hand-made or computer made, the form of the candidate will be rejected and the same would be considered as using unfair means and the candidate would be dealt with accordingly.</li> <li>3. Candidates are advised to take 6 to 8 passport size coloured photographs clear with white background.</li> <li>4. The candidate should scan his/her passport size photograph for uploading. File size must be between 10 kb to 200 kb.</li> </ol>
21.	Will any candidate be able to leave early if he finishes the test before the allocated test time?	No. The candidate will not be allowed to leave the examination hall/room before the test concludes.
22.	When is the AIAPGET-2025 going to be held?	Exam will be held on <b>4<sup>th</sup> July 2025</b> .
23.	When can Candidates download Admit Cards for AIAPGET-2025?	The candidates must view the NTA website regularly for updates.
24.	If a candidate is unable to download the Admit Card, whom should he/she contact?	Admit cards will not be sent to candidates. Candidates have to download the Admit Card from the website only. In case of any difficulty, mail us on <a href="mailto:aiapget@nta.ac.in">aiapget@nta.ac.in</a> or can call on helpline numbers mentioned in Information Bulletin.
25.	Can a candidate change the examination centre after allotment of roll number?	Examination Centre cannot be changed.
26.	If mistakenly during filling up of the form, wrong particulars are filled in the online form, how will it be corrected?	When the correction window is opened by NTA the correction in most of the particulars of Application Form can be made online and submitted. Once submission is done after correction no further correction will be allowed.
27.	Can anyone cancel the application submitted for AIAPGET?	Online Application forms submitted successfully cannot be cancelled/ withdrawn.



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28.	What is the minimum eligibility criteria/qualification for appearing in AIAPGET 2025?	Candidates in possession of BAMS/ BUMS/ BSMS/ BHMS/Graded BHMS degree or Provisional or Pass BAMS/ BUMS/ BSMS/ BHMS Pass Certificate recognized as per the provisions of the IMCC 1970/HCC 1973/ NCISM 2020/NCH 2020 Act and possess permanent or <b>provisional registration certificate</b> of BAMS/ BUMS/ BSMS/ BHMS/Graded BHMS degree qualification issued by the erstwhile CCIM / erstwhile CCH/NCISM/NCH/State/UT Board and have completed one year of internship or/are likely to complete the internship as per the NCISM/NCH notification, may apply for AIAPGET 2025 through Online Application Registration system at website <a href="https://exams.nta.ac.in/AIAPGET/">https://exams.nta.ac.in/AIAPGET/</a>
29.	What is the age limit/relaxation criteria for the candidates appearing in AIAPGET 2025?	No age limit for AIAPGET-2025.
30.	What is the reservation criteria for seats falling under the jurisdiction of States?	It is as per State Reservation Policy.
31.	Whether the Compulsory Rotating Internship has to be completed from one hospital only?	No. The twelve months Compulsory Rotating Internship can be from various hospitals, but the total time period of internship has to be of one year duration.



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32.	Whether the application fee excludes the Common Service charge?	Yes
33.	How can one remit fee for AIAPGET 2025?	Pay fee using HDFC/Canara/ Payment Gateway through Debit Card/Credit Card/Net Banking/UPI and keep proof of fee paid. In case the Confirmation Page is not generated after payment of fee then the transaction is cancelled, and amount will be refunded to the candidate's account. However, the candidate has to make another transaction, in case the Confirmation Page is not generated.
34.	If any candidate faces any problem in remittance of fee due to failed transaction, what can he/she do?	If the payment status of online transaction (by credit/debit card) is not communicated by payment gateway in real time then fee payment is not completed, and the candidate will not be able to download the Confirmation page. In this case, the candidate is required to pay the fee again through online mode and download the Confirmation page. The amount due to failed transaction of credit/debit card will be refunded back after reconciliation with the bank.
35.	If a candidate for any reason has not appeared in the examination, is there any provision for a fee refund?	No. Once the online application form is submitted successfully by the candidate, it cannot be withdrawn, and no refund will be made.
36.	Is Aadhaar mandatory for AIAPGET?	The Aadhaar number is only one of the types of identification and is not mandatory. Candidates may also enter Passport number, Ration Card number, Bank Account number or any other valid Government identity number.
