Conduct of Day 4 of the CUET (UG) – 2024 – reg.

The CUET (UG) – 2024 Examination began on 15 May 2024 at 2157 Examination Centres across the Country including 26 cities outside the Country. About 13.48 lakh unique candidates are taking the CUET (UG) in a hybrid format (CBT & Pen & Paper) for 57.95 lakh subject combinations. (8 days vs 34 last year).

Day 1, Day 2, and Day 3 of the examination were conducted successfully on 15, 16, and 17 May 2024.

Day 4 of the CUET (UG) - 2024 was conducted in approximately 603 examination Centres across the Country and abroad.

Today, the examination covered approximately 3.35 lakh test papers in subjects of History (314), Political Science (323), and Sociology (326), completing 5.8 percent of the total examination.

On Day 1, Day 2, and Day 3, the NTA successfully concluded tests for 25.91 lakh (44.71%), 15.81 lakh (27.29%), 5.39 (9.31%) combinations completed 81.31% of the total tests.

In total, 87.11% of the CUET (UG) – 2024 examination has been completed in **four days** (15, 16, 17, and 18 May 2024) with a significant increase in attendance as the examination schedule was announced well in advance, and all scheduled candidates were allotted Centres close to their residences, fulfilling their **first-choice preferences** based on present or permanent addresses.

The Subject-wise attendance (in percentage) for Day 1 (15 May 2024), Day 2 (16 May 2024), Day 3 (17 May 2024), and Day 4 (18 May 2024) is given below:

The NTA is committed to providing candidates with the best possible experience during the CUET (UG) - 2024 examination. Comprehensive arrangements have been made at the examination Centres to assist candidates, including the establishment of help desks, availability of various facilities, and special provisions for those who could not appear for the examination due to changes in the examination Centres or problems in downloading the Admit Cards.

Now, the CBT (Computer-Based Test) mode examination for remaining 48 subjects (31 languages and 17 domain specific subjects) will be conducted on 21, 22, and 24 May 2024 in more than 600 examination Centres located in about 300 cities across the Country and abroad. The Admit Cards to the concerned candidates for the same has already been issued.

The offline mode of the exam witnessed a high turnout of candidates, with a significant portion appearing for the English and General Test. The NTA ensured strict adherence to examination guidelines and protocols to maintain the integrity of the testing process.

The National Testing Agency (NTA) successfully conducted **Day 4 (18 May 2024)** of the CUET (UG) - 2024 exam. Minor challenges were efficiently addressed, ensuring a smooth examination process and a fair and secure environment for all test-takers.
